



Aurora Public Schools H1N1 Flu Shot Clinics

WHO:

Aurora Public Schools is hosting flu shot clinics for families and staff members who are considered at high risk for H1N1 influenza.

Target groups include:

- young people from 6 months to 24 years of age
- pregnant women
- health care workers
- adults who care for infants less than 6 months old
- adults from 25 to 64 years of age who have chronic health conditions like asthma or diabetes

WHAT:

- The vaccine is available at no charge at our flu clinics.
- **The vaccine protects against H1N1 only, and not seasonal flu.**
- Identification or proof of chronic disease is not required.
- Written consent from a parent or legal guardian will be required for anyone under 18 years of age.
- Parents must accompany students who are under age the age of 18 to the vaccination clinics.
- Children who are 10 and under will need to have a series of two injections, one month apart.
