LOCAL COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES or SOCIAL SERVICES (DHS or DSS)

This is where you can apply for many different government assistance programs, including Family Medicaid, Food Assistance (food stamps/Quest cards), Colorado Works/TANF (Temporary Aid to Needy Families-cash assistance), CCAP (child care assistance), CSE (child support enforcement) and LEAP (low-income energy assistance). Your county DHS or DSS is also responsible for providing Child Protection Services (CPS) and investigating any child abuse or neglect reports they receive.

WIC (Women, Infants & Children)

WIC is a federally funded nutrition program that can help with food for you and your children during and after your pregnancy. Items WIC

can help you with include milk, eggs, cheese, beans, juice, peanut butter, fortified cereals, etc. After you deliver the food will change some to include formula, rice cereal, and other foods for the baby. There are many WIC offices all over the Denver Metro area and throughout Colorado.
